

## Diamonds of a good presentation

- Cut everything which is not directly related to the subject
- Handwriting should be big enough on the blackboard
- Standing position should be somewhere far from the projected picture
- Explain outline of the presentation first
- Define every symbol before appearing in slides
- Do not use slide animations unless to explain an idea related to the subject
- Do a good colour management for better view
- Use polite sentences and do not get lost in details
- Remember Biometrika journal's parenthesis steps in formulas, which is [ { ( ) } ]
- Always think audiences are more clever than you but they know less
- Escape from elementary things rapidly and explain the problem clearly
- Balance the presentation for all, not too elementary, not too advanced
- Manage time during the presentation, leave some time for questions.
